



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

**Symposium: Forgotten Liberators –
A "Decolonised" History of the
Third World in World War II**

The symposium, in its third year under the aegis of the Steve Biko Foundation, the Steve Gubbins Foundation and the Centre for Understanding Africa at University of Fort Hare, accompanies the opening of an exhibition of the same name at the Steve Biko Centre, One Justice Street, Grahamstown, King William's Town (KWV), Eastern Cape.

The innovative exhibition, *Forgotten Liberators – A "Decolonised" History of the Third World in World War II*, celebrates and also includes in the canonised events who played a vital and neglected role in the fight against fascism during the Second World War.

It is envisaged that papers will represent work in progress presented by researchers working on topics related to the theme, of the situation of the so-called "free world" in that time in an effort to decolonisation in the new world order that emerged post-2. The symposium will take place on Thursday 5 July 2018 at the Steve Biko Centre, One Justice Street, Grahamstown, King William's Town (KWV), Eastern Cape.

Those allocated for the presentation of each paper will be twenty-five minutes, and time will be allocated for discussion of each paper or group of papers.

The closing date for the submission of abstracts is Friday 8 June 2018.
